

EXAMS OFFERED

ENTRY LEVEL CERTIFICATES

Designed for New Technicians

NATE entry level certificates are designed to help new technicians show they have mastered the basics. The certificates can also be used as a tool for contractors to make sure their newest technicians are ready to shadow others in the field.

Ready-to-Work

This entry-level exam is designed for technicians who are just entering the HVACR field, with little to no formal education or training. The exam focuses on fundamental job knowledge and skills and each exam order comes with a free downloadable study guide. The Ready-to-Work Certificate exam is available online only, does not require a proctor.

HVAC Support Technician

The HVAC Support Technician Certificate is designed for technicians with 6 to 12 months of experience. The exam covers topics linked to the NATE certification pathway, but at a more fundamental level. Earning this certificate demonstrates increased knowledge and skills, and strengthens the foundation needed to pursue NATE's professional certifications.



NATE CERTIFICATION

Two Pathways to Success

Technicians can choose between two different sets of exams, or pathways, to earn NATE Certification: The Certified HVAC Professional, or CHP-5, is made up of five 30-question exams, each on a specific subject area, and is designed for new technicians.

The Traditional Pathway is for experienced technicians looking to demonstrate their specialized experience and consists of a Core exam and a Specialty exam of your choice.

No matter which NATE certification, path a technician chooses, they are ensuring recognition of expertise and excellence in the industry.

TRADITIONAL PATHWAY

Technicians that choose the traditional NATE certification pathway will take two exams - the 50-question NATE Core exam and a 100-question Specialty exam.

NATE offers multiple Specialty exams for technicians to choose from, and technicians will earn an Installation or Service specialization depending on the exam completed. Once certified, technicians can also earn additional specialties, including a Senior Level Efficiency Analyst specialty.

The Core exam tests a candidate's construction knowledge and HVACR specific knowledge in the areas of: Safety, Tools, Basic Construction, Using Basic Science, Achieving Desired Conditions, Taking Temperature and Humidity Measurements, and Basic Electrical.

The Traditional Pathway is a great choice for experienced technicians that feel confident in their work and test taking abilities.


CHP-5 PATHWAY

The Certified HVAC Professional (CHP-5) is a new certification pathway designed to mesh a technician's training and certification efforts with their on-the-job learning.


This new way to earn NATE certification consists of five 30-question exams instead of our traditional 50-question core exam and 100-question specialty exam.

Each exam covers one of five different subject domains: HVAC Fundamentals, Electrical and Controls, Comfort and Airflow, Installation, and Service. NATE recommends taking the exams in order for the easiest progression, however technicians can take the exams in any order they choose.


Candidates can take up to six months between each exam to study and prepare.








Exam Subject Domains







Low-GWP Refrigerants Certification Exam

NATE is proud to introduce a new refrigeration exam and certification. The exam is designed to validate a technician's knowledge of the low-global warming potential (GWP) refrigerants becoming common in the HVACR industry due to new state and federal regulations.

While the new low-GWP refrigerants are more efficient, these products are also more advanced and complicated for HVACR technicians to work with. The NATE refrigerant exam is designed to ensure that technicians have the necessary skills and job knowledge to handle refrigerants of all types.



MAINTAINING CERTIFICATION

To maintain NATE Certification, technicians must recertify every two years by either:

1. Completing 16 hours of continuing education hours (CEHs) and paying a renewal fee.

Or:

2. Re-taking the specialty exam before the expiration date.


NATE recognizes and approves both online and classroom training that is relevant to a technician's specialization or covers broad topics like safety, electricity, controls, codes, and regulations. Training completed with a NATE Recognized Training Provider will be seamlessly added to a technician's myNATE account. For all other courses, technicians can submit proof of training online.


How it Works



Courses Offered



EXAM KATES

Each KATE includes the percentage of each subject on the exam, industry references and a clear outline of each topic that technicians should be familiar with before sitting for the exam. There are free downloadable KATEs for every NATE exam available on the NATE website.





TAKE EXAMS ONLINE

Live Online Proctoring

NATE now offers remote Live Online Proctored Exams for all NATE certification and certificate exams. Our Live Online Proctored Exams give technicians the opportunity to take their exam at the office or at home, at a time that fits their schedule.

A qualified proctor monitors remotely in real time using webcams in order to ensure the integrity of the exam. Trained professional remote proctors assure that our remote testing is secure and trustworthy, while giving you the flexibility to take the exam in a location of your choice. Technicians can register for an exam online through their myNATE account.

By testing online, you can minimize technicians' time away from the field. With this new exam option, certification becomes more attainable than ever, offering the dual benefits of flexibility and efficiency.

Take an active part in improving the quality of technician excellence by becoming a NATE Testing Organization. A NATE Testing Organization is an organization that agrees to follow the NATE testing protocols and offers at least one testing session a year. Testing organizations must have a minimum of one NATE approved proctor to oversee exams. A proctor can be any person who is a member of the Testing Organization and does not need to be NATE certified. Applications are free and can be completed online.



NATE C3 Program: Consumer Contractor Connection

With C3 membership, you not only receive the benefits of professionalism, customer confidence and profitability, you gain access to new customers. Whether you are a one-person shop or have NATE-certified technicians in multiple locations, NATE's C3 program is the best way to let customers know you employ NATE-certified technicians with a free listing on our contractor locator.

To qualify, a contractor must have at least 25 percent of its eligible service and installation technicians NATE-certified. You may then register to be listed on the NATE contractor locator with your company information and the technicians' NATE ID numbers.


